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G. B. MEETING

A meeting of the Governing Body, Sonapur College, Sonapur was held in the office of the principal at 3.30 PM. on 02.11.2019 with S. Balaram Mallik, Sub-collector, Sonapur and president, G. B. in chair. The following members were present there:

To begin with, the principal-cum-Secretary, Sri Tarun Kumar Mishra extended hearty and warm welcome to the new G.B. member, Sri Nirajan Tripathy, member of Hon'ble M.P. with an applause given by other members present in the meeting. In his address, the M.P. member Sri Tripathy ventilated the goodwill of Hon'ble M.P., Mrs Sangeta Kumari Singhdeo and made a request to the principal to supply some informations on the existing staff and students, structure, infrastructure and other relevant statistics and requirements of the college so that steps could be initiated to remove the deficiencies, if any. He also expressed his strong commitment to work hard for the all round development

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of this college. Then the agenda fixed for the meeting was placed for discussion.

Agenda 01: Leave Application of Dr P.L. Jena

The Directorate of Higher Education, Odisha had forwarded the leave application of Dr P.L. Jena, Associate Professor of Chemistry to the G.B. Somapuro Degree College, Somapur for approval. After discussion, the following resolution was adopted-

Res. 01: After verifying relevant records, such as balance position of E.L., medical certificate, etc., the G.B. unanimously approved the E.L. availed by Dr P.L. Jena, Associate Professor of Chemistry for the period from Dt 20.08.2017 to Dt 24.05.2018 and requested the principal to do the needful.

Agenda 02: Maternity leave of Mrs Arati Munda.

Mrs Arati Munda, lecturer in English had availed maternity leave and DHE, Odisha had forwarded her leave application for the approval of G.B.. All relevant records were referred and verified.

Res. 02: The maternity leave of Mrs Arati Munda, Lect. in English ranging from Dt. 01.11.2018 to Dt 29.04.2019 was unanimously approved.

Agenda 03: Increase of Rent of College canteen

The principal intimated the members that from the very beginning, the proprietor of the college canteen has been paying only Rs 1500/- Per month in form of rent which is very meagre.

Res. 03: Unanimously resolved to increase the canteen rent from Rs 1500/- (one thousand and five hundred) to Rs 3000/- (Rupees three

thousand) per month. The principal was requested to communicate the message to the proprietor and also to collect the rent from him in the revised rate from the month of January 2020.

Agenda 04: Approval and appointment of P.E.T. and Clerk

The principal produced before the G.B. the result of the interview conducted in the college for the post of one P.E.T and one Clerk where Sri Kalyan Ch. Mohapatra and Sri Abhilash Tripathy had topped the list for the post of P.E.T. and Clerk respectively.

Res. 04: The G.B. unanimously resolved to approve the result of the Selection Committee and appoint the selected candidates Sri Kalyan Ch. Mohapatra and Sri Abhilash Tripathy in the post of P.E.T. and Clerk respectively and advised the principal to issue appointment letters to both of them as per rule. Further the merit list prepared by the committee for this purpose was also approved so that the subsequent position holders can be invited for joining in case the selected candidates do not turn up to the college for joining.

Agenda 05: Report of the I.O. on the suspended employees.

The Investigating Officer, Sri Tarun Kumar Mishra produced his report on the investigation conducted by him on the suspended employees Sri R.N. Mishra, Demonstrator and Sri P.K. Bagh, Accountant.

After going through the report, it was learnt that the report was not clear cut and categorical. Therefore, the I. O. was requested to prepare the report once again and to produce the same in the next meeting.

Agenda 06: Application of Sri R.N. Mishra and Sri P.K. Bagh for re-instatement.

The applications submitted by the suspended employees Sri R.N. Mishra, Demonstrator and Sri P.K. Bagh, Accountant for their reinstatement were taken into account, but the appeal was deferred till the submission of report by the Investigating Officer.

Agenda 07: Appointment of Advocate for the Hearing conducted by the D.H.E, Odisha

During the time of last Hearing in the office of the Director in relation to the Suspension of Sri R.N. Mishra, Demonstrator and Sri P.K. Bagh, Accountant, the opposition party had appointed advocate for pleading their case. Therefore the Principal had sought permission for being heard through an advocate from the side of the Principal and the G.B. ^{& the DHE, Odisha} granted permission for the same.

Res. 05: Unanimously resolved to appoint an advocate to facilitate argument during Hearing with the DHE, Odisha in relation to the Suspension of Sri R.N. Mishra and Sri P.K. Bagh and the cost for such appointment be borne by this college.

Agenda 07: Extension of Suspension period of Dr P.L. Jena, Associate Professor of Chemistry and Sri R.N. Mishra, Demonstrator

Res. 06: Awaiting the approval of the

of the Director to the proposal of suspension of Dr P. L. Jena, Associate Prof. of Chemistry and Sri R. N. Mishra, Demonstrator, their suspension period is further extended from 02.11.2019 to 02.12.2019 and the Principal was requested to communicate the matter to the Director, H.E, Odisha.

Agenda 09: Incentive of Block Grant Employee:

In connection with the appeal made by the Block Grant Employees of the College, the letter of the Government in the Dept. of Higher Education, Odisha bearing No. 21530 dt 15.10.2019 was referred and it was learnt that no additional salary can be paid to any employee in excess of the salary received in form of full G.I.A. / Block Grant.

Res. 07: Unanimously resolved to stop the payment of incentives to the Block Grant employees of the college who are receiving or eligible to receive G.I.A. 2017 with immediate effect.

Agenda 10: Any Other -

(i) Case of Lt. A. N. Dash, ANO, NCC.

The principal informed the members about the serious allegations of NCC cadets of the college against Lt A.N. Dash, ANO, NCC on which the Body expressed deep concern and the following resolutions were made:

Res. 08: (a) The NCC cadets who have brought allegations ^{against} Lt A.N. Dash, ANO be invited by the principal to establish

their stand;

- (b) A stricture in this respect be issued to Lt. Dash, ANO.
- (c) A general notice be given to the student cadets not to pay any such fee or extra payment. If such things are repeated, they are to bring it to the notice of the Authority immediately.
- (d) The principal will remain present at the time of distribution of 'B' and 'C' certificates so as to avoid such illegal and indiscent practices.

(b) Appeal of Sri Somanath Mishra, Laboratory Attendant for Salary Advance.

The principal produced the application of Sri Mishra who had appealed for salary advance for treatment of his ailing wife suffering from heart problem.

Res. 09: The Body unanimously resolved to approve the payment of salary advance of Rs 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty thousand) only to Sri Somanath Mishra, Lab. Attendant on special ground with the condition that the said advance be deducted in two instalments soon after the receipt of Block Grant ~~from~~ salary from DHE, Odisha and in one instalment in case the arrear salary is received by him.
