


Mishra, Reader in Sanskrit and the Vice-Principal on

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.









A crucial meetings of the G.B. was held on dt. 05.02.19 at 3 P.M. in the office of the Principal with Sd. Balaram Mullick, President of the G.B. in chair. The members signat above were present.

At the outset, the members of the G.B. extended hearty welcome to Prof. Tarun Ku. Mishra, Associate Professor in ^{Physics} ~~Chemistry~~ and vice-Principal for his debut as ^{the} new member of the G.B. following the retirement of Prof. Bhaskar Prasad Mishra on dt. 30.11.2018.

The Principal subsequently readout the resolutions of the previous meetings and confirmed.

Resolution No-01:

The Special Audit Report submitted by M/s Kojuridi & Co. in response to the G.B. Resolution No-02 dt. 04.10.18 was placed before the G.B. for discussion. The members expressed grave concern for the financial irregularities to the tune of Rs 76 lakhs in construction and repair works during the sessions 2015-16 and 2016-2017. The above audit report treats it as breach of trust, misappropriation and unauthorised exercise of financial powers. Accordingly, the said report recommended suitable legal action against the then Principal/C Dr Prigalata Jena, Sd. Rabinarayan Mishra, Demonstrator of Chemistry and executant of works and Sd. Paramod Ku. Bagle, Accountant. The President, G.B. apprised the members that the prolonged students' strike in August 2017 ^{had} demanded impartial enquiry into this issue and the District Administration had appointed an Enquiry Committee to investigate the matter. But due to the transfer of the then Collector Sd. Dasarathi Satpathy, the work could not be accomplished.

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The G.B. vide Resolution No-03 dt. ^{03.08} 4.10.18 appointed an internal audit committee comprising the Accounts Bursar Sri S.K. Mahapatra, Reader in Commerce and Additional Accounts Bursar Sri D. Barik, Lecturer in Commerce to probe into the matter and submit report within fifteen days i.e. by 25.10.18. The internal audit report pointed out serious objections against the construction and repair works summarily based on false and fabricated bills and vouchers and violation of prescribed procedure. The G.B. vide Resolution No-02 dt. 4.10.18 resolved to appoint have special audit to authenticate the internal audit report. Accordingly, M/s Kesriwal & Co. was entrusted with the responsibility of accomplishing the job as mentioned above. The members presented considerably that such ^{Local} financial lapses were flatly overlooked by the District Fund Auditor and A.G. Auditor preceding the Special Audit by M/s Kesriwal & Co. The members thoroughly examined the Special Audit Report along with the compliances submitted by Dr P.L. Jena, Sri R.N. Mishra and Sri P.K. Bagh and unanimously passed the following resolutions:

- (i) Suspension of Dr P.L. Jena, Sri R.N. Mishra and Sri P.K. Bagh with immediate effect.
- (ii) Lodging FIR against ~~them~~ Dr P.L. Jena and Sri R.N. Mishra and Sri P.K. Bagh.
- (iii) Initiation of departmental disciplinary proceedings against them.

The Principal was authorised to execute the same.

Resolution No.2

The Principal placed before the G.B. IDP Budget of Rs 18 lakhs along with the purchase of CBCS books of 4th semester to the tune of Rs 1.5 lakhs and was unanimously approved.

Resolution No. 03

On the EPF issue, the G.B. resolved that the Principal should regularise the EPF of the Block Grant Employees only after consulting EPF Advocate and P.F. Commissioner.

Resolution No- 04



Resolution No. 05
